

RULES AND REGULATIONS
PERTAINING TO THE USE FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES OF THE RESERVOIR ON HILLABEE CREEK
KNOWN AS SITE #11 AND THE SAM H. HAMNER RESERVOIR KNOWN AS SITE #6

1. NO fishing or boating shall be permitted on, or within, the lake or any of the waters of Hillabee Creek Reservoir and the Sam H. Hamner Reservoir owned or controlled by the Anniston Water Works and Sewer Board, a public corporation, (hereinafter "AWWSB"), unless a written permit is granted therefore by the General Manager or other AWWSB personnel authorized by him to do so.
2. Applications for permits shall be made at AWWSB office for an issuance fee of Five Dollars (\$5), and NO permit shall be granted for a longer period of time than twelve (12) months. Persons under 16 will not be required to have a permit. However, persons under 16 must be accompanied by an adult with a permit to be allowed on the premises.
3. In exchange for the privileges granted by the fishing permit, the permittee hereby holds harmless AWWSB, its officers, agents, and employee from any and all claims of every kind for personal injury and for damages to personal property.
4. Any permit granted hereunder may be revoked by the AWWSB, the General Manager, or his designee, for the violation of any of these rules or for any other cause deemed to be sufficient by the Board of Directors or General Manager, or his designee, of the AWWSB. More particularly, no person shall borrow, lend, or alter any permit. The permit of any person who does so may be revoked.
5. Those with permits to fish acknowledge that they will be fishing in areas where dangerous wildlife lives, including, without limitation, snakes and alligators. Persons fishing in these areas are responsible for their own safety and that of others with them, most particularly persons under the age of sixteen (16) years.
6. NO person shall be permitted to have, use, keep or operate a boat on said waters propelled by any other means than electric trolling motors. Boats that achieve propulsion by means of wind forces (sailboats, etc.) are prohibited. Boats with gasoline engines permanently attached thereto shall be permitted after the removal of the gasoline tank. Boats with permanently fixed gasoline tanks will be allowed if the outboard drive of same is tilted and locked in position. USE OF GASOLINE ENGINES ON SAID WATERS WILL RESULT IN PERMANENT REVOCATION OF PERMIT. NO permit will be granted for commercial fishing or any fishing other than recreational or sport fishing.
7. NO fishing or boating shall be permitted on the water herein referred to except during daylight hours, which are defined to be from one hour before sunrise until one hour after sunset. NO commercial, trotline or jug fishing shall be permitted.
8. NO boats shall be moored, docked or left at anchor in or on said water except when in use, it being the intention hereof that no one be permitted to keep or maintain regularly a boat or boats on said lake. NO boathouse, dock, shack, facility, or structure of any kind shall be constructed or maintained on any land or water belonging to The AWWSB.
9. NO person shall cause or permit any litter or refuse of any kind to be thrown into said reservoir or the land of the AWWSB adjacent thereto, including but not limited to cans, food, paper, bottles, or any other materials, article or thing of any kind that might contaminate the water of said reservoir or create unsanitary or unsightly conditions in or around same.
10. All laws of the State of Alabama, Department of Environmental Management and all regulations of the Alabama State Department of Health that are now or may hereafter be in effect and applicable to said reservoir shall be faithfully adhered to by all persons holding permits to use said lakes for any purpose.
11. NO swimming, water skiing or water sports (other than fishing) of any kind shall be permitted in or on said reservoirs and no one shall be permitted to have in his possession in any boat on said reservoir any water skiing equipment or any other equipment for water sports.
12. NO firearms/weapons of any kind shall be allowed on the water or on property belonging to the AWWSB. This includes crossbows, bow & arrows, and spear guns.
13. NO camping or campfires shall be permitted on reservoir property.
14. NO vehicles of any type or description, including, without limitation, four-wheeler and motorcycles, shall be allowed on the dam structures.
15. The reservoirs of the AWWSB are protected by the United States Code, Title 42, and violations of these rules are subject to prosecution under same.
