NATURE OF WORK

Work involves responsibility for the municipal and industrial wastewater operations, general maintenance, repair, and upkeep of the wastewater treatment plants physical facilities, equipment, and plant machinery. Maintains compliance with ADEM, EPA, and Anniston Water Works and Sewer Board regulations.

Works under the supervision of the Wastewater Plant Supervisor.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Knowledge of EPA, ADEM, occupational hazards, safety precautions, and departmental rules, regulations, methods, and technical requirements involved in municipal wastewater distribution.
- Knowledge of methods and materials utilized in the conduct of laboratory tests relating to the treatment and purification of wastewater.
- Ability to read and understand blueprints of buildings, pipe, and electrical schematics.
- Operating the Wastewater Treatment Plant; turns pumps, generators, filters, and valves on and off as necessary to ensure a safe and compliant discharge.
- Monitors meters, graphs, alarms, indicators, lights and numerical read-outs and manipulates controls to ensure the processing of wastewater.
- Utilizes SCADA system to control and monitor water quality.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Grade IV Water certification/license in the State of Alabama.

Must possess or obtain a valid driver's license with insurable driving record.
